Just few number to show how strong and increasing is our collaboration

- 96 scholarships have been offered to our students since 2016 (with a total fund of 400 k€) for short visits and up to 3 years PhD.
 For a total of more than 300months !
- More than 40 students have followed lectures at University Paris-Sacaly at different levels : Master 2, Master 1, and from 2nd to 4th year Bachelor. [from Physics and Engineering Departments]
- Several months of visiting of staffs (professors and administrative) at An-Najah and at Orsay
- 4 PHD students + 3 starting in Oct. 2021 from An-Najah are doing their PHD at IJCLab Orsay) in ALICE, ATLAS, ThomX, VIRGO/SVOM
